For a real treat, finish the morning off with a chance to witness the Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace or Horse Guards Parade. Departs: When operated by Evan Evans Tours the tour departs from Victoria Coach Station and finishes at Trafalgar Square. When operated by Trafalgar the tour departs from our hotels and finishes at our London Reception Centre.

City & Tower An unforgettable step back in time

Uncover the history of our capital city, from the great fire to the Blitz – our tour takes you on a journey to where it all began. St Paul's Cathedral built between 1675 and 1710 crowned by the magnificent dome, in recent years it has seen the marriage of Charles and Diana. Sunday in London: St Paul's Cathedral is closed to visitors, we will stop for photographs and spend more time at the Tower of London.
